The introduction of AEO status is the EU's response to the need to secure international supply chains. Designed to fit with Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (C-TPAT) in the USA and other 3rd countries operating under a Mutual Recognition agreement, AEO is based on, and is compatible with, the World Customs Organisation's SAFE Framework of Standards which is being implemented by Customs authorities across the globe.
